PE and Sport Premium Allocation 2018 - 19

For 2018 - 19 the school's allocation of PE and Sport Premium funding is **£19 640**

This funding will be spent in order to meet three key aims:

- **To improve the quality of PE provision particularly with regards to the development of active learning on the playgrounds and through providing high quality resources for use in PE lessons**
- **To increase participation in physical exercise and competitive sport through staff CPD**
- **To support and involve the least active children by providing targeted activities, lunchtime staff and entry into sports competitions**

Staff Cover for PE Leader or other members of staff to attend courses	£250	To provide cover when staff members attend PE courses to improve skills and understanding of PE.
Specialist PE provision for after school clubs- Gymnastics Team training	£800	To ensure that participation in local sports competitions is maximised and the number of pupils taking part in extracurricular sport is increased.
Specialist PE Equipment	£2000	To provide staff with resources to help them to teach PE and sport more effectively To enhance the quality of engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity.The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement.
Lunchtime equipment	£250	To provide opportunities at lunch time for children to become more active through playing with equipment and resources
Affiliation to British Schools Gymnastics Association Trampolining	£12 £10	Increased numbers of children taking part in physical activity after school.The school competes in Gymnastics Competitions.
Specialist PE Coach	£9943.88	To provide quality specialist P.E lessons for all pupils and deliver the PE curriculum.
