

## PE and Sport Premium Allocation 2014-15

For 2014-15 the school's allocation of PE and Sport Premium funding was £9736. This funding was spent in order to meet three key aims:

- **To improve the quality of PE provision**
- **To increase participation in PE and competitive sport**
- **To develop PE and Sporting opportunities outside of the school curriculum**
